

BYLAW No. P90/1960

A BYLAW TO ENFORCE THE USE OF COVERS ON TRUCKS, ETC.

UNDER THE NOXIOUS WEEDS ACT

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 of the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

(1) Before any grain, fodder, field crop seeds, crushed grain or cleanings of any kind is moved within the Municipality it must be covered in such a manner as to prevent the spread of noxious weed seeds which it may contain.

(2) Boxes on vehicles used to transport any of the materials mentioned in paragraph (1) of this bylaw shall be covered with a securely fastened tarpaulin or similar cover when moving anywhere within the Municipality.

(3) All screenings being transported within the Municipality must be covered with a securely fastened tarpaulin or similar cover when moving anywhere within the Municipality.

(4) A legible card, containing the provisions of this bylaw shall be conspicuously posted in all elevators, seed cleaning plants and seed warehouses within the Municipality.

(5) Any person or persons found guilty of a violation of any of the provisions of this bylaw, shall be on summary conviction liable to a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 or in default of payment of the fine to imprisonment of not less than 5 days nor more than 30 days,
