

- 3. The R. M. of Harris No. 316 and the Village of Harris agree that the fire fighting equipment mentioned in this agreement and supported by the amounts also mentioned in this agreement will be available for all residents of each municipality on an equal opportunity basis.

4. The housing of the said fire fighting equipment shall remain the responsibility of the Village of Harris.
