

BYLAW NO. 8/2005

**A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 8(2) OF THE MUNICIPALITY ACT.**

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be known as and referred to as "the General Penalty Bylaw" of the Municipality.
2. Sections 3, 4 and 5 apply to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of **The Municipality Act** or any other Act, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$10,000.00.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of **The Municipality Act** or any other Act, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$25,000.00.
5. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, in the case of a continuing offense, to a maximum daily fine of not more that \$2,500.00 per day.
6. Bylaw No. 3-1990 is hereby repealed.
7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2006.
