BYLAW NO. 8/2005

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 8(2) OF THE MUNICIPALITY ACT.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as and referred to as "the General Penalty Bylaw" of the Municipality.
- 2. Sections 3, 4 and 5 apply to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of *The Municipality Act* or any other Act, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$10,000.00.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of *The Municipality Act* or any other Act, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$25,000.00.
- 5. Subject to the provisions of Section 2, in the case of a continuing offense, to a maximum daily fine of not more that \$2,500.00 per day.
- 6. Bylaw No. 3-1990 is hereby repealed.

7. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2006.
