

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316 TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS 'THE OLD BONE TRAIL' IN THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316 AS BEING A SITE OF ARCHITECTURAL AND/OR HISTORICAL VALUE.

WHEREAS Part III of The Heritage Property Act authorizes the council of a municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings and structures thereon, to be of architectural, historical or natural value or interest, and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 has caused to be served on the owners of the lands and premises known as 'The Old Bone Trail' situated on the SE 28-32-12-W3rd

a Notice of Intention to so designate the aforesaid real property and has caused such Notice of Intention to be published in at least 2 issues of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality with the first publication at least 21 days prior to the date of consideration of the bylaw and with the last publication at least 7 days prior to the date of that consideration; and

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed designation has been served on the administrator of the municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 enacts as follows:

1. There is designated as being of architectural and/or historical value or interest the real property known as 'The Old Bone Trail' situated on the SE 28-32-12-W3rd and legally described as:
Part of Legal Subdivision One (1), of Section 28 in Township 32, in Range 12, West of the Third Meridian.

The significance of the site is as follows:

- a. This is one of the few remaining original peices of the 'Old Bone Trail' still in existance and has never been cultivated.
- b. The trail was used by virtually every settler to gain access to their homesteads in this part of the Province.

2. The R. M. Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be registered against the property described above in the proper Land Titles Office.

3. The R. M. Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a copy of this bylaw to be served on the owner of the aforesaid property and on the Minister and to cause notice of the passing of this bylaw.

4. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the final passing thereof.
