

BYLAW NO. 5-2005

TAX CERTIFICATE BYLAW

A **BYLAW** of the Rural Municipality of Harris No.316 in the Province of Saskatchewan to Provide for a fee charged for issuing a Tax Certificate, And Further to Provide for a Designated Officer.

THE COUNCIL FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Short Title

This Bylaw may be cited as the Tax Certificate Bylaw.

2. Purpose and Scope

- (a) Establish a Fee for the purpose of issuing a Tax Certificate
- (b) Establish a Designated Officer(s) for the purpose of issuing a Tax Certificate.

3. Fee

The Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 hereby sets the fee for the issuance of a Tax Certificate at \$20.00

4. Designated Officer

The Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 hereby designates the Administrator and/or the Assistant Administrator as the designated officer to issue a Tax Certificate.

5. Coming into Force

This bylaw shall come into force January 1, 2006.
