BYLAW No. P88/1959

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS No. 316 OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLEARANCE FROM A DEFINED AREA ADJACENT TO CERTAIN ROADS OF STONE PILES, PORTABLE STRUCTURES, MACHINERY, TREES, SHRUBS OR OTHER OBJECTS

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Harris No.316 of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
- (a) "road" means any road in the municipality, other than a provincial highway;
- (b) "area" means any area, whether within the municipality, or in an adjoining municipality, bordering upon a road as so defined, having a width not exceeding one hundred and fifty feet, measured from the centre of such road.
- 2. The Council may by resolution provide for the carrying out at the expense of the municipality of the following works or any of them:
 - (a) the removal from any area designated in such resolution of stone piles, portable structures, machinery or other objects placed in such area;
 - (b) subject to section 4, the removal from any area designated in such resolution of brush, trees or shrubs growing in such area, whether growing before or after the passing of this bylaw;
 - (c) the transplanting of any brush, trees or shrubs removed from any area pursuant to clause (b) hereof.
- 3. The Council may by resolution appoint agents or servants to act for and in behalf of the municipality in carrying out any work authorized pursuant to section 2, and any agent or servant so appointed may enter upon private property for the purpose of carrying out such work.
- 4. Nothing in section 2 (b) hereof shall be deemed to apply to any brush, trees or shrubs which:
 - (a) were planted more than five years prior to the passing of this bylaw; and
 - (h) ama ward as a shelter bolt; and
 - (c) are situated more than seventy-five feet from the centre of the road referred to in such resolution.
- 5. This bylaw shall be read and construed as being subject to the provisions of any bylaw heretofore or hereafter passed by the Council under authority of paragraph 70 of section 188 (1) of The Rural Municipality Act.
- 6. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw, or who obstructs or interferes with any agent or servant of the municipality engaged in exercising on behalf of the municipality any of the powers conferred by this bylaw, is guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties as provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality, being number P84/1958 passed on the 2nd day of June, 1958.

7. Bylaw No. 81 passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Harris, No. 316 of Saskatchewan on the Ath day of February A.D. 1957 is hereby repealed.
