4. Calls from the owner municipality will always have priority for calls.						
<ol> <li>The call from a fire department must be made to the nearest participating fire department.</li> </ol>						
<ol> <li>Fire calls to the participating municipalities must be con- firmed by the fire department of the calling municipality.</li> </ol>						
7. Standby backup calls-calls made by one municipality to another for standby when their equipment has been called. These shall be placed in the same manner as an actual fire call. (see #5&6)						
8. Billing will be made to the calling party, the guarantor being the municipality or fire commission of the fire call location.
