

Bylaw No. 2/1991

A Bylaw to Provide For Entering Into An Agreement  
Respecting The Provision of Fire Protection Services

The Council of the R. M. of Harris No. 316 in the  
Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The R. M. of Harris No. 316 is hereby authorized to enter  
into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this  
bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A, with the following  
municipalities:

R.M. of Eagle Creek #376	Village of Harris
R.M. of Montrose #315	Town of Asquith
R.M. of Perdue #346	Town of Delisle
R.M. of Vanscoy #345	Village of Perdue
R.M. of Biggar #347	Village of Vanscoy
R.M. of Glenside #377	Village of Arelee
	Village of Kinley

for the purpose of providing and/or receiving fire protection  
services.

2. The Reeve and Administrator  
of the R. M. of Harris No. 316 are hereby authorized to sign  
and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit A.

Memorandum of Agreement made this 7th day of May 1991 A.D.

This Agreement Witnesseth as Follows:

1. The parties to this agreement agree to jointly provide fire protection services to all residents residing within the designated area for each of the municipalities party to the Agreement.
  
2. The parties to this agreement further agree that
  1. Municipality means a municipality participating in and signing the agreement.
  2. Standby means informed & ready to move from home station.
  3. A participating municipality will answer the call of any other participating municipality on a first come first serve basis. (including back up calls)
  4. Calls from the owner municipality will always have priority for calls.
  5. The call from a fire department must be made to the nearest participating fire department.
  6. Fire calls to the participating municipalities must be confirmed by the fire department of the calling municipality.
  7. Standby backup calls-calls made by one municipality to another for standby when their equipment has been called. These shall be placed in the same manner as an actual fire call.(see #5&6)
  8. Billing will be made to the calling party, the guarantor being the municipality or fire commission of the fire call location.
  9. Call Rates:
    - (a) See attached appendix (set by each council)
    - (b) Other Equipment as per Rural Affairs and Highways Policy Manual or any other established schedule.
    - (c) No insurance coverage for fire call - major costs over a set figure (set by mutual aid district) will be absorbed by the aid district for those municipalities within the Eagle creek Mutual Aid District and on a Mutual Aid District Call.
  
3. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall commence on May 7th, 1991 and be continuous. The agreement may be terminated by either/any party to the agreement giving thirty days notice in writing.
