Bylaw No. 4-2001

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316 RESPECTING ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE.

Under the authority and subject to *The Stray Animals Act 1977*, the council of The Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 enacts as follows:

- 1. Expressions used in this bylaw shall have the same meaning and interpretations as given to them by Section 2 of *The Stray Animals Act 1977*.
- 2. The following animals owned by burgesses of the municipality shall be permitted to run at large within the areas herein described during the periods named respectively.

AREA: All of the area within the road allowance adjacent to the following properties:

- ▶ West of NW 16 33 10 W3rd
- West of SW 21 33 10 -W3rd

PERIOD: January 1st to December 31st of each year.

ANIMALS TO RUN AT LARGE:

Cattle only or progeny thereof.

3. Animals will be allowed to run at large during all hours of the day.
