

## **FIRE SERVICES ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT**

**THIS AGREEMENT** made in duplicate effective the   7   day of   November  , 2019.

**BETWEEN:**

**THE BIGGAR RURAL DISTRICT FIRE ASSOCIATION,**

A group of municipalities in the Province of Saskatchewan, being  
The Rural Municipality of Biggar No. 347, The Rural Municipality of Glenside No. 377,  
The Rural Municipality of Rosemount No. 378, The Rural Municipality of Grandview No. 349 &  
The Town of Biggar

and

**THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316**

in the Province of Saskatchewan

**WHEREAS** both parties, either on their own or in conjunction with others, provide firefighting and/or rescue services within their respective boundaries;

**AND** whereas each party may have need to allow the other to provide firefighting and/or rescue service should need arise within their respective boundaries,

**NOW** therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants and undertakings herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

That, subject to the availability of fire-fighting and/or rescue personnel and equipment, a party may, if requested by the other, provide firefighting and/or rescue service to the other.

Where one party provides firefighting and/or rescue services to the other, the latter shall compensate the former at the former's rates in force at the time of request.

Accounts shall be rendered as soon as practicable after the service is provided and shall be paid within one month of the same being rendered.

The party receiving the required service agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the other party providing the service, as well as its officials, employees, agents or volunteers, from and against all claims which may be brought by any person, firm or corporation for any injury, death or loss suffered as a result of the provision of services under this agreement.


The preceding clause shall apply even if the injury, death or loss was caused by the negligence of the party providing the service, its officials, employees, agents or volunteers, however it shall not apply if the injury, death or loss was caused by the gross negligence or intentional acts of the party providing the service, its officials, employees, agents or volunteers.

This agreement shall continue until such time as either party terminates it, by providing the other with 60 days written notice.






