Bylaw No. 1-2005

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HARRIS NO. 316 RESPECTING THE BANNING OF RAISING RATS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY.

Under the authority and subject to *The Rural Municipality Act 1989* (the act), the council of The Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 enacts as follows:

- 1. The R. M. of Harris No. 316 hereby declares, pursuant to Section 216 (1) (c) of the Act, any species of rat to be dangerous.
- 2. The R. M. of Harris No. 316, pursuant to Section 216 (1) (d) of the Act, prohibits any person from keeping, possessing or harbouring of any species of rat within the municipality.
- 3. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in Bylaw 3/1990, (*The General Penalty Bylaw* of the municipality)
