

A BYLAW RE: THE REMOVAL OF TREES WITHIN THREE HUNDRED FEET OF INTERSECTIONS OF MUNICIPAL ROADS

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Harris No. 316 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Council of the said municipality is hereby authorized to provide for the removal of trees and shrubs growing on private property at or adjacent to and within three hundred feet from intersections of municipal roads.
2. Any such obstruction, whether growing before or after the adoption of this bylaw, may be removed at the expense of the municipality, and for so doing the person appointed by the Council shall have the right of entry upon any private property.
3. Any person found guilty of infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw, and any person who refuses the right of entry, or who in any way hinders entry upon land for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence, and liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality, No. p84/58 passed on June 9th, 1958.
